



ENVINT srl at workshop on improving regional air quality in China Beijing (China), 2-3 March, 2017



Dr Ivo Allegrini, General Manager of ENVINT srl has participated to a meeting on regional air pollution in Beijing, China, on March 2nd and 3rd. The meeting has been organized by ADB (Asian Development Bank) and the Advisory Technical Assistance (TA). ADB is actively involved into the process of reducing air pollution in BTH (Beijing-Tianjin-Hebei) Region and on surrounding provinces such as Inner Mongolia, Shaanxi etc. Dr. Allegrini has already got a contract with ADB in order to study policies and approach to air pollution control at international level. The meeting has been attended by more than 100 people representative of institutions involved in the control of air pollution in BTH region.

Dr. Allegrini presented a technical report on "air quality management at airshed level in Europe". The presentation summarized the technical achievements within European Union in order to control air pollution on mesoscale homogenous areas, i.e., in areas characterized by pollution from several sources under the responsibility of different institutions belonging different Member States or,

within the same Member States, belonging different regional and provincial institutions.

A special attention has been given to Po Valley which present many similarities with BTH region. Cooperation and collaboration among the institutions at central and local level, with the active role of European Commission, is the key approach for an effective control of polluting sources. Examples in Europe and, possibly, in other regions in advanced Countries may provide the basis to reduce pollution in Beijing area and to provide more and more "Blue Sky" days to Chinese people.
